7 Commandments



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1st Commandment

- ▣ Deal Disruptions with Little Interruption
 - Manage positively
 - Don't waste time in dealing disruptions
 - Move around your classroom
 - Stand besides the students
 - Keep them in focus, ask questions
 - Use humor

Turn minuses into pluses

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2nd Commandment

- ▣ Avoid direct Confrontations
 - Don't humiliate students

Don't make pluses into minuses

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2nd Commandment

- ▣ Avoid direct Confrontations
 - Don't humiliate students
 - Don't yell.
 - ▣ It causes embarrassment and it loosens your control
 - ▣ It creates loss of trust

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3rd Commandment

- Treat friendly but not as their friend


4th Commandment




- Establish class rules
- Have some class rules to be followed and the consequences to be known
- Make rules understandable
- Be consistent in enforcing your class rules.
- Don't be inconsistent in accepting late works

5th Commandment




- ▣ Involve your students with activities

A study on student involvement found that:
Student Involvements are highest for students in teacher-led small group and lowest for lecture presentation





6th Commandment

- Do Not Act Biased or Unfair
- Fairness is Key

7th Commandment

- ▣ It is easier to get easier, so don't be easy at the beginning
 - Start the semester tough
 - But don't turn your classroom a torture cell
 - Be easier later.

Do's


- ▣ Move around
 - To reduce noise
 - To invigilate during exam
 - Follow Chinese style during exam



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Do's

- ▣ Move around
- ▣ Know your students names
- ▣ Follow one spot for getting attention



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Do's

- ▣ Move around
- ▣ Know your students names
- ▣ Follow one spot for getting attention
- ▣ Praise and recognize students effort
- ▣ Display students' successful work in the classroom.

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Don'ts

- ▣ Don't claim and act in a way that you know all
- ▣ Don't affected by hello effect. Start fresh everyday
- ▣ Don't talk about your private life
